ENTRIES: Entries will be done on spellbound.horsespot.net. There will be a post entry fee of \$30 per horse/rider entry if entered after May 20th at 6:00 PM. No numbers will be issued without an open check, signed release and coggins.

CHECK OR CASH ONLY ACCEPTED- NO DIGITAL PAYMENT METHODS ACCEPTED

CLASS FEES: Individual classes are \$25 each. Jumper classic and mini derby entry \$35.

STALLS: Limited stabling available on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls are available Friday-Sunday and are \$100 with shavings included. Please contact Tracey at 214-402-6472 to reserve stalls. Stalls must be prepaid the Monday before the show and are non-refundable unless otherwise filled or if the show is postponed due to rain.

SHOW FEES: \$35 office/EMT fee will be charged to every horse & rider combination. Any open checks not closed out at the end of the day will be charged a \$15 open check fee. A non-member fee of \$35 will apply to riders that are not members of DHJSC. Trainers **MUST** be members of DHJSC. Membership must be completed online at dallashunterjumperscholarship.com. **Non-showing entries will be charged a \$50 schooling/EMT fee and must be emailed in prior to the show and issued a back number. Entries that school and scratch will be charged a non showing fee.**

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

SCHOOLING: No schooling will be available on Friday. Saturday jumper schooling 6:30-7:30am. Ticketed schooling may be available Saturday afternoon in both arenas once the courses are reset, time permitting. Sunday Ring 1 schooling 6:30-7:45am, there will be a schooling break prior to the 2'6 divisions. Ring 2 schooling WT crossrails daybreak-7:30, WT Poles only 7:30-7:45. Dedicated schooling break for WTC crossrails prior to the division start.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

Must enter class and alert gate that you are competing in the Classic prior to the 2nd hunter round. Horses in multiple divisions will do their derby round at their highest fence height.

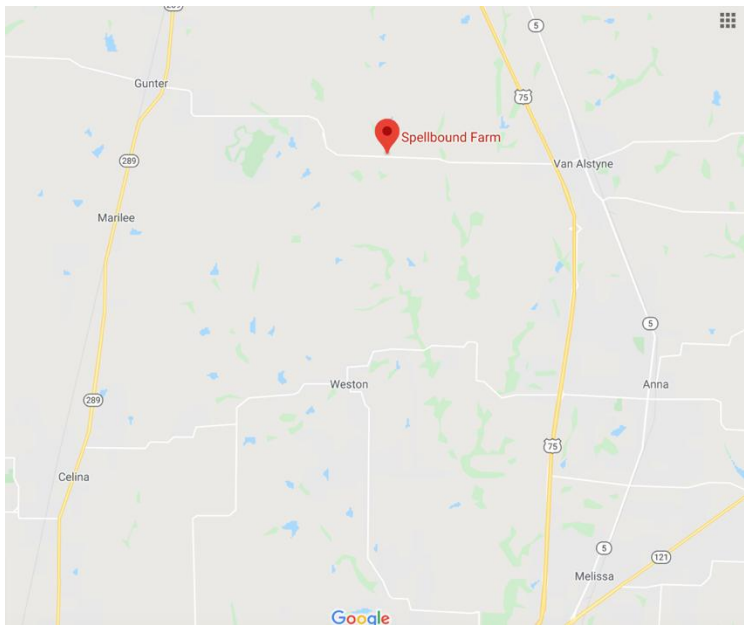

ARENAS: Ring 1: 135x250 covered arena with custom Kiser footing. Ring 2: 100x200 with sand footing. Warm-up areas are fenced grass paddocks.

ATTIRE: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Polo shirts are permitted in Jumpers.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM: This show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach>

SPLIT/COMBINING CLASSES: A class will be split if there are 16 or more riders that compete in the class. Individual classes may also be split (i.e. Equitation classes). HUNTER divisions having 16 or more competed rounds in the first class will be split regardless of how many riders compete in the following classes. If the first class does not have 16 or more riders that compete then the division will stand with one pinning. Divisions that are split will award 2 Champions and reserves and each entry will receive the corresponding points. Jumper rounds will be split by class and only if two or more classes are split there will be 2 Champions and 2 Reserves. Warm-up classes will not be split regardless of entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be combined or canceled at show management's discretion.

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference or less.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available with food and drinks. No credit cards accepted.
