Show Rules & Information

Entries: Please submit entries via amec.horsespot.net. E-mailed entries will not be accepted. **Please submit entries by June 17.** A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received after 11:59 PM June 17. **Please reserve your stalls and shavings via the barn account on Horse Spot.**

Class Fees: All classes are \$25 unless otherwise stated. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or else the class fee may be charged. Adds and scratches at the gate are not allowed; they must be done in the office first.

Stall Fees: \$100 each, from Friday – Sunday. Shavings: \$12/bag (3 minimum). Limited VIP Stalls are available for \$175. No outside shavings allowed. Early Move-In or Late Move-Out available for \$35 per night, including tack stalls. Please request early move-in with the show secretary either via the online entry form with your entries, or on your barn order.

Show Fees: A \$35 office/awards/EMT fee will be charged to each horse/rider combination. Non-members will be charged a non-member fee of \$35/show. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK OR CARD ON FILE.

Returned Checks: A \$50 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Non-Showing Entries: Non-showing entries will be charged a \$40 schooling fee, in addition to show and stall or grounds fee. Non-showing entries are required to pay office and EMT fees. All horses on the grounds must be registered in the show office, provide coggins and vaccination proof, and receive a back number.

Health Records: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a copy of the original Coggins which must be uploaded to Horse Spot with entries. CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON HORSE SPOT FOR ALL HORSES ENTERING THE SHOW FACILITY. Negative Coggins is required for non-showing entries as well. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Vaccination records include: documentation from veterinarian with name of given vaccinations and date. If given by other, receipt of purchase, name, serial #, expiration date, and date of administration. Please attach all health records to the online entry before check-in to avoid delays.

Schooling: There will be open schooling in all rings from Friday from 1:00 PM until 6:00 PM. Schooling prior to ring start according to the times posted on the schedule.

Awards: All classes receive a first place prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. All divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and prize will be awarded and Reserve Champion rosette.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag, and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

Concessions: Concessions will be available during show hours.

Arenas: Both arenas are 150' x 250' with sand footing.

Show Management: Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move, or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

USHJA Outreach Program: The show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach>. Riders and horses wishing to earn points toward USHJA Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA on or before the first day of competition to earn points. Riders who compete in one Outreach class are eligible to compete in Outreach Festivals.

Warning: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Responsibility Notice: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless DHJSC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show officials and management against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against DHJSC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show management and officials by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action of proceeding by council acceptable to the owner. The Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and DHJSC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show management are not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft. It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers, and spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanlike manner. It is the responsibility of all trainers and exhibitors to be familiar with the DHJSC Rulebook.

JUMPER MEDAL To be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgement, and execution of an efficient track. The judge will issue a numerical score based on the rider's medal round. One point will be deducted for every second over time allowed (if posted) and four points will be deducted for each knockdown or refusal. At the year-end show the top size in each class will compete in a flat workoff. The points for placings from the year in the case of a tie, the current standing points will have more weight than the year end points.
