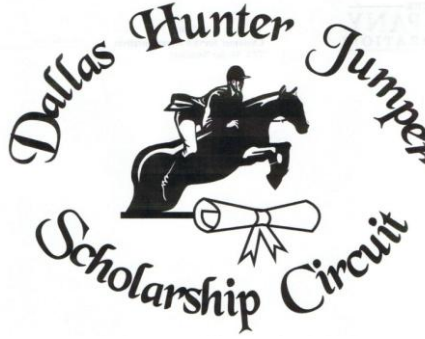

GUIDELINES

- It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers, and spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanlike manner.
- It is the responsibility of all trainers and exhibitors to be familiar with the DHJSC Rulebook.
- All children must be accompanied/supervised by an adult.
- A \$15 service fee may be applied to open checks not closed by the conclusion of the show.
- Excessive coaching by trainers, parents, guardians or other riders from the in-gate is not permitted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHOOLING: Sun. daybreak - 7:45 am

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Prospering Farm and DHJSC officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Prospering Farm and DHJSC Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by counsel acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Prospering Farm and DHJSC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft

ENTRIES: Each Class Fee- \$25. **There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per entry, after Oct. 6**

Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

CROSS ENTRY A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. This includes equitation flat and under saddle classes.

FEES & REFUNDS: \$35

.00 office and awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged.

NONMEMBER FEE- If you are not a member then there is a nonmember fee of \$35.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

DOGS: There will be NO DOGS on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!!

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

PAYMENT: We only accept Cash and Checks. No digital payments.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10,6,4,2,1 &.5. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes.

FOOTING: Warm Up areas and Competition arenas are sand. Ring 1 is 175 X 275, Ring 2 is 125X225

Hunter Ring 3 is 100 x200

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled.

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins Report within one year must be shown/emailed ahead of time.

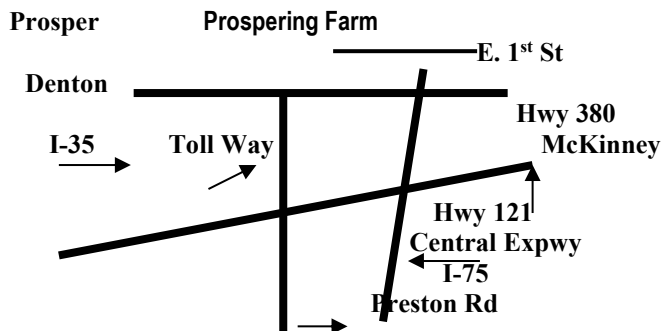
